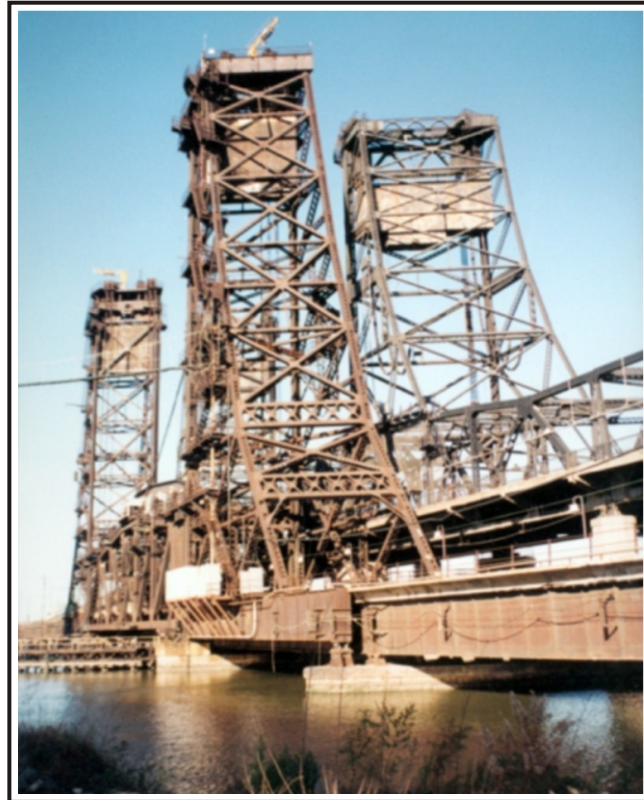

RGA is presently conducting cultural resources mitigation in accordance with a Memorandum of Agreement prepared to mitigate the adverse effect on the National Register-eligible Wittpen Bridge over Hackensack River. RGA had completed the Section 106 Cultural Resources Investigation for the project that identified the historic, vertical lift Wittpen Bridge and the Hackensack River Vertical Lift Bridges Historic District. RGA's recordation of the Wittpen Bridge, conducted in accordance with the standards of the Historic American Engineering Record, focused on the individual historic and technological significance of the bridge as well as its setting and relationship to the Hackensack River Vertical Lift Bridges Historic District. RGA is preparing a popular document that illustrates the historical and technological significance of the Hackensack River Vertical Lift Bridges Historic District.
